

Application scheme to Danish Preferred: **Industry test**

Deadline: November 1st

Conditions for application for industry test:

- Positive Stress test from the previous harvest year.
- A minimum of 150 tones of barley available for large scale malting. In case the industry test will be done in one year (three industry maltings) 850 tons of barley is required. (the industry test can be spread over two seasons, if preferred by the applicant).

Information concerning the process:

- It is the applicant's own responsibility to organize the industry testing. After application Fuglsang and Viking Malt, will be notified on which varieties will go through the industry test. Furthermore, one abroad partner, will be assigned for the variety.
- Results from the malting and brewing should be send both to the applicant and to the Danish preferred secretary. Schemes for reporting are available on the website.
- There will be two annual meeting, where the Danish Preferred Committee can take decisions for the varieties in industry tests. First meeting is late January, second meeting in mid-June.
- If the applicant does not find the results from the industry test satisfying, the applicant can decide not to apply for full approval.
- Only varieties which has at least 750 ha. of multiplication is granted full approval (at approval in January plans for multiplication in the coming spring must be shown). The minimum acreage is relevant for conventional varieties. Less acreage will be required for specialty barleys - like null-lox, DMS, organic varieties, winter barley and others.
